Ring 1 - Working Hunter Classes

Starts 9.00 a.m.

Judge: Mr R Donaldson

- Class 1** **Green Working Hunter Pony 15 HH or 153cm and under**
(fences max 2'3" – 70cm) For ponies never to have been placed in a novice or above Working Hunter or Hunter Trials or One Day Event and to have no BSJA winnings.
- Class 2** **Novice Working Hunter Pony 15HH or 153cm and under**
(fences max 2' 9" – 85cm) For ponies never to have been placed in an open Working Hunter class and not to have more than £50 BSJA winnings.
- Class 3** **Open Working Hunter Pony 15 HH or 153cm and under**
(fences max 3' 3" – 1m) Open to all ponies.

The Working Hunter Pony Championship for classes 1 – 3 will take place after class 3. 1st and 2nd prize winners will be eligible.

- Class 4** **Green Working Hunter Horse over 15 HH or 153cm**
(fences max 2' 3" – 70cm) For horses never to have been placed in a novice or above Working Hunter or Hunter Trials or One Day Event and to have no BSJA winnings.
- Class 5** **Novice Working Hunter Horse over 15HH or 153cm**
(fences max 2' 9" – 85cm) For horses never to have been placed in an open Working Hunter class and not to have more than £50 BSJA winnings.
- Class 6** **Anivac/British Riding Clubs Working Hunter Qualifier for Blair Horse Trials.**
You will be asked to jump a course of 8 to 12 fences approx 3'3" (1m) in height. Classes will be judged in line with the Sport Horse Breeding Society of Great Britain Rules. Riding hats to be in accordance with the current BRC Rule Book. The first THREE prizewinners will qualify for the Final to be held at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Thursday 27 August 2009. Riders must be 17 years or over on the day of the competition. To be eligible for the qualifying rounds and final the rider must be a member of a Riding Club affiliated to BRC. Horses must be 153cm or over and at least 4 years old and must not have won £150 or more in BSJA classes nor have more than 3 BE points.
- Class 7** **Open Working Hunter Horse over 15 HH or 153cm (fences max 3' 6" – 1.05m)** Open to all horses.

The Working Hunter Horse Championship for classes 4 – 7 will take place after class 7. 1st and 2nd prize winners will be eligible.

Ring 2 - Ridden Classes

- Class 8 Lead Rein Pony**
Open to riders aged 10 years and under riding any suitable pony.
- Class 9 Ridden Pony**
15hh or under.
- Class 10 M & M Ridden Pony**
Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies - Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Sections A,B,C,D. Rider any age.
- Class 11 Riding Club Pony**
Ponies 15 hh (153cm) or under, to be ridden in a snaffle bridle with no martingale or spurs.

Any Ponies (under 15hh) placed 1st or 2nd in classes 8-20 are eligible for the Pony Championship which will take place after class 20.

- Class 12 Riding Club Horse**
Horses over (153cm) 15 hh to be ridden in a snaffle bridle with no martingale or spurs.
- Class 13 M & M Ridden Horse**
Open to large Mountain & Moorland breeds.
- Class 14 Ridden Veteran**
Open to horses and ponies aged 16 and over.
- Class 15 Ridden Coloured**
Open to horses and ponies.
- Class 16 Ridden Appaloosa, Palomino, Roan & Any other unusual colour.** Open to horses and ponies.
- Class 17 Ridden Pure/Part/Anglo Arab**
Will be split pure/part bred if entries permit. Open to horses and ponies.
- Class 18 Ridden Cob**
Not to exceed 15.1hh to be shown natural or hogged and trimmed.
- Class 19 Ridden Maxi Cob**
Over 15.1hh to be shown natural or hogged and trimmed. (Classes 18 & 19 may be amalgamated if insufficient entries).
- Class 20 Ex-Racers Club ridden Blair Qualifier**
class for ex race horses. All horses should be registered with the Ex Racers Club before entry. All first and second placed entrants qualify for the Ex Racers Club Scottish Championships to be held at Blair Castle Horse Trials Sunday 30th August 2009. All wetherbys registered TBs who have been in training or have raced are eligible to register with the Ex Racers Club for a one time fee of £10. See www.exracersclub.com for details.

Any Horses (over 15hh) placed 1st or 2nd in classes 12-20 are eligible for the Horse Championship which will take place after class 20.

Ring 3 - Ridden Hunters/Hacks

- Class 21 Riding Horse**
Horses exceeding 14.2 hh (148cm). Will be split small/large if entries permit.
- Class 22 Lightweight Hunter**
Open to horses exceeding 15.2hh (158cm)
- Class 23 Small Hunter**
Open to horses between 14.2hh (148cm) and 15.3hh (158cm)
- Class 24 Middleweight/Heavyweight Hunter**
Open to horses exceeding 15.2hh (158cm)
Class may be split if entries allow.
Please specify on entry form if Middle or Heavyweight.
- Class 25 Ridden Hacks**
Open to horses exceeding 14.2hh (148cm)
- Class 26 Ridden Sport Horse**
Competition Horse, exceeding 15hh (153cm).
- Class 27 Ridden Traditional Heavyweight**
15hh and over pure/part bred Clydesdale, Shire, Percheron, Ardennes or any other draught breed.
If Part bred must be at least 50%

**The Championship for classes 21 – 27 will take place after class 27.
1st and 2nd prize winners will be eligible.**

**All Champions and Reserve Champions from Arena 2 & 3 will be eligible
for the overall Championship which will be held in Ring 3 after rings 2 &
3 are finished.**

Ring 4 – Show Jumping

Class 28 British Horse Feeds/BHS Scotland Riding Club Style Jumping Series 2009 – [BRC Style Judge - Mrs J Robertson](#)

The British Horse Feeds/BHS Scotland Riding Club Style Jumping Series 2009 offers riders the chance to prove they can ride a course of show jumps in good rhythm and with the correct riding position. The winner of the series will be the person who rides most efficiently with impulsion and balance over a course designed to encourage a flowing round of jumping. This popular and positive competition judges both horse and rider as a combination in a way that is constructive and improving. Fences are a maximum of **85cm** in height. **The final will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Sunday 30 August 2009. 1st to 4th qualify.**

- Competitors will jump one round consisting of seven fences including a double and a stile, or narrow fence. Maximum height 85cm.
- The course will be timed at 350 metres per minute.
- To be ridden in a snaffle bridle.
- A whip between 45 and 75cm may be carried.
- No spurs allowed.
- A running martingale may be worn but will incur a penalty of 5 points.
- Each fence is judged out of 10. Penalties are given for refusals (first disobedience 3 penalties, second 6 and third is elimination) or knock downs (2 penalties) and riders are eliminated for a fall or if they **fail to salute before commencing their round.**
- Upon entering the arena the competitor will halt in front of the judge and **salute**. They should then proceed to canter on both reins, until the signal to start is given (bell or horn). The course should then be jumped and upon completion the competitor should continue to canter until the judge gives the signal to leave the arena (bell or horn). There is no need to salute before leaving the arena.

Rules and regulations

1. Rosettes will be awarded for 1st to 6th place.
2. Ages are as at 1st January 2009, with the exception of the Blair Qualifier Working Hunter class.
3. Horses/Ponies must be four years old or over.
4. Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, & 7 will be judged 60% on jumping style and performance and 40% for conformation. No change of saddlery will be permitted throughout the competition. Any suitable bridle may be worn although we would prefer 4 year olds to be shown in a snaffle. Horse boots/bandages should be removed if you are asked by the judge to come back into the arena for the showing section of the class. Spurs are permitted.
5. If in the event of there being large entries in the Working Hunter classes, horse/pony and rider combinations may be restricted to entering one Working Hunter class only.
6. The committee reserves the right to alter, divide or cancel any of the classes, and to transfer entries, which in their opinion are in the wrong class, with or without giving a reason.
7. Findon Riding Club will not be held responsible for any complaint regarding horses or ponies entered in the wrong class, but will act as a mediator provided the complainant has proof on the day of the show.
8. At or in the vicinity of any Findon Riding Club event, everyone mounted, whether competing or not must wear a hard hat conforming to the minimum safety standards (EN1384) with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Hard hats to specification PAS015:1998, ASTM F1163 and BSEN14572:2005 are considered to offer greater protection than EN1384. Skullcaps must be worn with an appropriate coloured silk.
9. The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
10. Disclaimer of liability – save for death or personal injury caused by negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor the agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
11. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
12. The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions listed above.
13. The number of entries in each class will be published on our website on the Thursday prior to the competition www.findonrc.co.uk for the purpose of competitors working out rough times.

DIRECTIONS TO OLDFOLD SHOW FIELDS:

Travelling from Aberdeen: proceed along North Deeside Road (A93) through Cults. On entering Milltimber, proceed **past** the entrance to Oldfold Farm and take the first right onto Binghill Road (there is a traffic island in the middle of this junction). Proceed up the hill and the show fields are on the right hand side.
